- \* Function key

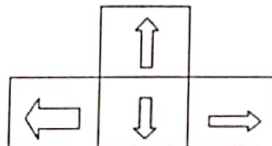
Alphabet key - Alphabet keys are used to type letters A to Z.








Number keys - Numbers keys are used to type number 0-9






