(Reproduction in Animals)

1. What is reproduction ?

Ans: The process of producing one's own kind is known as reproduction.

2. What is life span ?

Ans: Living beings give birth to young ones. The young ones grow into adult and then get old and after some time they die. This is called a life span.

3. What is incubation ?

Ans: The male and female birds take turn to sit on the eggs to keep the babies inside warm through a process called incubation.

4. What is hatching ?

Ans: After few days, eggs break and a baby bird comes out. This is called hatching.

5. What is yolk ?

Ans: The centre of the egg is yellow in colour and is called yolk.

6. What is albumen ?

Ans: The yolk is surrounded by a watery transparent medium called albumen.

7. What is fry ?

Ans: The eggs of the fish grow into fish known as fry.
