Q.1 What is a sentence ?

A sentence is a group of words that makes a complete sense.

Some examples of sentences are –

1. **Rakesh** is a good dancer.
2. **Why** were you absent yesterday?
3. **What** a pleasant day it is!
4. I play football everyday.

Thus we can see that

:- A sentence is a group of words.

:- That makes complete sense.

:- It has a verb or an action word (underlined)

:- It begins with a capital letter (Highlighted in bold)

:- It ends with full stop (.) Or question mark (?) Or an exclamation mark (!)

REMEMBER

A sentence always has a verb.
