SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

A sentence can be divided into two parts.

Subject and Predicate.

Example:-Riya is a good student.

Ans: Riya is a good girl.

Subject predicate

'Riya' is the subject because the sentence is about the 'Riya'.

The word 'is good student' is the predicate because this part tells us something about the subject 'Riya'.

Let us read some more sentences.

Subject		Predicate		
(i)	Birds	Fly.		
(ii)	The birds	Flew away.		
(iii)	The two birds	Were feeling scared.		

• Usually ,the subject come **before** the predicate but often for emphasis, the predicate **can** come **before** the subject.

Example:- 1. In that jungle lived a lion

Predicate subject
