## English Preposition

"The word which comes before noun or pronoun and it shows relation with other words is called preposition."

ex ⇒ A bird is quick of eye.  
The boy sat on the chair.  
She is in room.

There are seven kinds of preposition.

① Simple Preposition ⇒

on, at, by, for, in, to, up etc.

② Compound Preposition ⇒

without, within, between, behind etc.

③ Double Preposition ⇒

up to, out of, in to, from above etc.

ex ⇒ Fill the correct preposition.

① father is angry — you. (with, to, by)

② she lives — Kampus. (in, on, at)

③ He fell — the well. (in, into, with)

④ The moon is — us. (upon, above, over)

⑤ she played — the girls.  
(between, by, among)

⑥ Ram sits — Raja.  
(to, near, of)
